Bank of India tame KFC Colts 5-1

MUMBAI: Bank of India struck top form to score a come from behind 5-1 win against a young, spirited Kenkre FC Under-19 in a Super Division match of the MDFA (Mumbai District Football Association) League, played at the St. Xavier's ground, Parel, here on Wednesday. After Abuzar Beg scored first for Kenkre, Jagdish Mhadada led Bank of India's fight back with two goals. Rahul Solanki, Shadab Sheikh and Cleutus Chandrashekar scored one apiece to complete the banker's win. The bankmen took time to settle down and in the process also conceded the lead when Kenkre FC striker Abuzar Beg against the run of play scored in the 34th minute. But the bankers regrouped and quickly got into their groove before taking control of the proceedings. Mhadada struck in the 44th minute to help the bankmen go into the break on level terms. However, after the change of ends, Bank of India upped the ante and scored four more goals to knock the fight out off their young opponents. In the 55th minute Solanki netted the second before Shaikh consolidated the lead (3-1) in the 69th minute. Later Chandrashekar and Mhadada scored two goals in quick succession in the final ten minutes to wrap up the victory.

SINDHU, KASHYAP, GURUSAIDUTT WIN IN ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIP

NEW DELHI: Indian shuttlers PV Sindhu, Parupalli Kashyap and R M V Gurusaidutt made a positive start to their campaign by winning their respective opening round matches at the USD 200,000 Asian Badminton championship in Gimcheon, Korea.

However, it was curtains for Singapore Open semifinalist Kidambi Srikanth as he went down to Chinese veteran Lin Dan 7-21 14-21 in 32 minutes in a men's singles first round match. World No. 10 Sindhu faced a tough challenge from Hong Kong's Cheung Ngan Yi before prevail over her opponent 21-15 15-21 21-18 in a women's singles match that lasted an hour.

Sindhu will next face Hirose Eriko of Japan in the next round.



Hirose has a 3-0 lead against the Indian.

Kashyap and Gurusaidutt registered contrasting victories in their respective men's singles matches.

While Kashyap posted a comfortable 21-14 21-17 win over Goh Soon Huat of Malaysia in 35 minutes, Gurusaidutt fought hard before posting a 22-20 23-21 victory over Phetpradab Khsit of Thailand in a 44-minute contest.

In the second round, Kashyap will take on Hsu Jen Hao of Taipei, while Gurusaidutt will clash against another shuttler from Taipei, Wang Tzu Wei. In the men's doubles event, Indian pair of Manu Attri and B Sumeeth Reddy lost to Malaysia's Low Juan Shen and Heg Nelson Wei Keat 21-16 13-21 20-22.



Malinga is Sri Lanka's new T20 skipper, Chandimal gets the boot

COLOMBO: Paceman Lasith Malinga, who led Sri Lanka to World Twenty20 title in Bangladesh, has been rewarded with the captaincy in the shortest format as struggling batsman Dinesh Chandimal got the axe.

Chandimal originally was the captain of the side but Malinga had led the team in the final three games, including the summit clash, as stand-in skipper in their successful campaign. Chandimal, who at 23 became Sri Lanka's youngest captain in any format last year, has seen a dip in his batting form during the World T20. Left-hand batsman Lahiru Thirimanna has been appointed as Malinga's deputy and will also be vice-captain in the Test and ODI team under skipper Angelo Mathews. The World T20 win became Sri Lanka's first major international title since they won the World Cup in 1996 under Arjuna Ranatunga.

The SLC sources added that the current contract dispute with the national squad would soon be over as the players had agreed to a new payment formula for annual contracts. The players have expressed willingness to accept 10 per cent from the ICC revenues derived by the SLC.

Kandivali CC and Shivai CC to clash in finals

MUMBAI: Two of the top cricket academies in the city - Kandivali CC and Shivai CC will clash in the final of the U-12 Premier League, organised by Cricket India Academy (CIA) - the Cricket division of SEDIL (Sports Education Development India Ltd).

In the first semi-final, Shreyas Mandlik, captaining the Shivai Cricket Club were provided a steady start courtesy their openers to put up a challenging score of 209.

The batting unit of MIG Cricket Club collapsed, as the Shivai Cricket Club captain leading from the front, took a solitary yet crucial wicket in 8.4 overs, giving away just 10 runs. Shreyas Mandlik won the man of the match for his brilliant batting of 88 runs in 95 balls.

The second semi-final played between Kandivali Cricket Club and Karnataka Sporting Association began on a low note but gained momentum later on. Manal Kawle 69*(95 balls) and Adil Khan 20(12 balls) put up a partnership of 89 runs. Suryansh Shedje also scored 53 runs in just
